



As the largest, oldest and only statewide organization dedicated to expanding the Texas wine industry for everyone and protecting the rights and privileges of G-permit holders.


Representing nearly 1,200 individual members and hundreds of winery and vineyard businesses we are the largest wine association in the state and one of the largest in the nation.



Texas Wine and Grape Industry

- Contributes more than \$20.35 billion of economic value to the State of Texas
- 141,235 full-time jobs, paying \$6.9 billion in wages
- 2.02 million tourist visits to Texas wineries and \$685.86 million in annual tourism expenditures, making Texas #2 in the nation
- Produces over 10,000 different wines from over 80 varietals
- Approaching 900 G Permits in Texas, #3 in the nation
- The Texas wine industry generates sizeable tax revenues on the local, state, and national levels. In 2022, the industry will pay nearly \$387.30 million in state and local taxes, and \$1.01 billion in federal taxes for a total of \$1.40 billion. In addition, the industry generates approximately \$60.46 million federal consumption taxes and \$726.25 million in state consumption taxes which include excise and sales taxes.
